

FAC Policy for Returning to FAC Facilities After Exposure to COVID-19

FAC implements these protocols based on CDC recommendations for the following situations.

Person knows he/she had COVID-19

This person is able to return to FAC after...

- 5 days since symptoms first appeared or tested positive **AND**
- has no symptoms and symptoms are resolving
- **OR** has tested negative for COVID-19

Person has been exposed to an individual with COVID-19

This person is able to return to FAC after (for those who are unvaccinated)...

- Person has self-quarantined for 5 days **after exposure AND**
- Never developed symptoms **OR**
- Has tested negative for COVID-19 (recommended to test on day 5)
 - *Person should wear a mask around others for the next 5 days after quarantine*

People who are vaccinated do not have to self-quarantine, but must wear a mask and social distance within 5 days of exposure. It is recommended to test on day 5.
